was an active member of the Akademischer Motorsportverein Zürich (AMZ Racing) during the 2024/2025 and 2025/2026 season.

Dominique joined the team in September 2024 as a Freelancer, contributing primarily to the chassis and aerodynamics module. During the 2024/2025 season, he was responsible for the integration of sensors from placement to mechanical fixtures for the race car «*aurora*». Additionally, he contributed largely to the manufacturing of carbon fibre parts. Building on this experience, he continued his role for the 2025/2026 season, where he contributed directly to the aerodynamics and electronics module. He developed an entirely new front-end for the CFD interface to increase the user experience and thus accelerate development. Additionally he created a Plugin for NX Siemens which enables users to directly extract the CFD simulation files from the CAD model.

Furthermore, Dominique used his software skills to spontaneously rework the front- and backend of the dashboard, a component that allows effortless communication from drivers and engineers to the main control unit of the vehicle, thus critical for the successful participation of Formula Student Events. Lastly, for the Rendering used in all kinds of presentations and posters, Dominique set up the environment from concept to implementing the carbon fibre material textures.

His work focuses on software algorithms, data-driven vehicle state assessment and the testing and validation of AMZ's Formula Student race cars. Dominique carries out his tasks

with diligence, independence, and technical expertise, while demonstrating flexibility, and leadership skills.
